The Transportation Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 178**, SCHOOL ZONE SPEEDING AMENDMENTS, by Representative C. S. Moss, with the following amendments:

1 Line 24 through 38:

24 (2) (a) A violation of Subsection (1) is a class C misdemeanor and the minimum fine:

25 (i) for a first offense shall be calculated according to the following schedule:

30 (ii) for a second and subsequent offense within three years of a previous conviction

31 {or bail forfeiture} shall be calculated according to the following schedule:
