Mr. President:

The Transportation, Public Utilities, Energy, and Technology Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **2nd Sub. H.B. 178**, SCHOOL ZONE SPEEDING AMENDMENTS, by Representative C. S. Moss, with the following amendments:

Amendment 1

1 Line 24 through 39:

24 hour in a reduced speed school zone as defined in Section 41-6a-303.

25 (2) (a) A violation of Subsection (1) is a class C misdemeanor and the minimum fine:

26 (i) for a first offense shall be calculated according to the following schedule:

31 (ii) for a second and subsequent offense within three years of a previous conviction {f}

32 **or bail forfeiture** {f} shall be calculated according to the following schedule:

37 (b) [(i)] Except as provided under Subsection (2)(a)(ii), the court may order the person
