The Government Operations and Political Subdivisions Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 548**, PRIMARY ELECTION AMENDMENTS, by Representative A. Stoddard, with the following amendments:

Amendment 1

1 Line 316 through 322:

316 election for the office may not be held and the candidates are considered nominated;

317 (b) exceeds twice but does not exceed three times the number of individuals needed to

318 fill that office, a primary election for the office may be held; or

319 (c) exceeds three times the number of individuals needed to {file} fill that office, a
primary

320 election for the office shall be held.

321 (3) (a) For purposes of this Subsection (3), "convention" means an organized assembly of

322 voters or delegates.
