Mr. Speaker:

The Political Subdivisions Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. S.B. 130**, RIVER RESTORATION AMENDMENTS, by Senator L. Fillmore, with the following amendments:

Amendment 1

1 Line 11 through 17:

- 11 Jordan River; and
- 12 #requiring the division to consult with the Jordan River Commission before expending
- 13 money for an improvement project;
- 14 #creates a matching grant program for {~~counties and municipalities~~} **a county,**
- municipality, or the Jordan River Commission** to fund improvement
- 15 projects that increase access to a recreational activity on the Jordan River;
- 16 #appropriates funding for the matching grant program; and
- 17 #makes technical and conforming changes.

2 Line 116 through 126:

- 116 center, or other educational program located [~~within the zone~~] along the Jordan
- 117 River; and
- 118 (B) renew the grant described in Subsection (5)(b)(ii)(A) every five years.
- 119 (iii) The division may issue a matching grant to a county {~~or~~ , municipality , or the
- commission** for an
- 120 improvement project that increases recreational access on the Jordan River, if the

Amendment 2

1 Line 119 through 125:

- 119 (iii) The division may issue a matching grant to a county or municipality for an
120 improvement project that increases recreational access on the Jordan River, if the
121 county or municipality:
122 (A) provides **at least** an equal amount of matching funds; and
123 (B) certifies that the county or municipality will spend the grant funds on an
124 improvement project that increases recreational access or improves public
125 safety along the Jordan River.
