The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **2nd Sub. S.B. 154, PROTECTION AND ADVOCACY AGENCY REPORTING**, by Senator T. Weiler, with the following amendments:

Amendment 2

1 *Line 55 through 61:*

- 55 (i) are not capable of living independently;
- 56 (ii) can live somewhat independently, with formal supports;
- 57 (iii) live independently; and
- 58 (iv) are a family member of a disabled individual; { **and** }
- (e) the number of individuals that the state protection and advocacy agency:
- (i) referred to and received voluntary treatment;
- (ii) petitioned for and were ordered into involuntary treatment;
- (iii) exited from homelessness into a residential or clinical setting;
- (iv) was able to advocate for assisted outpatient treatment or assertive community
- treatment that resulted in placement or acquisition of supportive housing; and
- (v) advocated for with the goal of discontinuing any aspect of services or treatment
- deemed to be appropriate for the need of the individual; and
