The Health and Human Services Committee recommends **3rd Sub. S.B. 170**, VITAMIN K AMENDMENTS, by Senator J. Plumb, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **4th Sub. S.B. 170**, VITAMIN K AMENDMENTS with the following amendments, and, due to unknown fiscal impact, recommends it be referred to the Rules Committee pending completion of a fiscal note.

Amendment 1

1 *Line 26 through 30:*

- 26 provide a full and clear explanation of the risks and benefits of vitamin K administration
27 and the risks of possible adverse health outcomes for a newborn that does not receive
28 vitamin K.
29 (3) A parent may decline to consent to the administration of vitamin K . {~~The form~~
described }
- 30 {~~in Subsection (3) shall be part of the newborn infant's medical record.~~}
