Mr. President:

The Business and Labor Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 182**, ATTORNEY ADMISSION TO JAIL FACILITIES AMENDMENTS, by Senator S. Pitcher, with the following amendments:

## Amendment 1

1 *Line 28 through 34:*

- 28 (b) informs the sheriff that the attorney wishes to meet with a prisoner who is at the jail.
- 29 (2) An attorney may meet with a prisoner under Subsection (1) if the prisoner is:
- 30 (a) the attorney's current or former client;
- 31 (b) a prospective client **and the meeting:**  
**(i) was requested by the prisoner, the prisoner's family, or by a person on behalf of the**  
**prisoner ; or**  
**(ii) the potential representation is for a civil rights matter;**
- 32 (c) a potential witness to a criminal case that the attorney is prosecuting or defending; or
- 33 (d) an individual who may have information pertinent to a criminal case that the attorney
- 34 is prosecuting or defending.
