The Transportation, Public Utilities, Energy, and Technology Committee recommends **S.B. 190**, TRAILER REGISTRATION AMENDMENTS, by Senator B. Brammer, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **2nd Sub. S.B. 190**, TRAILER REGISTRATION AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

Amendment 1

1 *Line 57 through 64:*

57 the same vehicle registered for a 12-month period.

58 (3) (a) A person may register a trailer for the lifetime of the period during which the
59 vehicle is titled by the person.

60 (b) An interstate apportioned vehicle registered in accordance with Section 41-1a-301 :
(i) is

61 not eligible for lifetime registration described in Subsection (3)(a) { } ; and
(ii) is eligible for lifetime registration described in Section 41-1a-228.

62 (c) To register a trailer as described in Subsection (3)(a), the person is required to pay
63 the amount of any tax or fee that would be due for the same vehicle registered for a
