The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.C.R. 1**, CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REGARDING NUCLEAR ENERGY, by Senator D. R. Owens, with the following amendments:

Amendment 1

1 Line 37 through 43:

37 WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes the importance of maintaining high standards for
38 nuclear safety and environmental protection while enabling states to participate responsibly in
39 regulatory oversight:
40 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the state of Utah, the
Governor concurring therein,
41 expresses intent to pursue Agreement State status for elements of the nuclear fuel cycle not
42 expressly prohibited and encourages the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to clarify which
43 portions of the fuel cycle are reserved by statute versus policy.
