Enactment of this Legislation could cost the Department of Environmental Quality \$2,900 one-time and \$36,500 ongoing from federal funds to provide training and technical assistance to community water systems in developing their security plans, to develop a reporting structure for drinking water systems, and to draft an annual report on security incidents. The agency has indicated they can absorb this cost from previously authorized federal funds.
