Enactment of this legislation could increase Federal Funds revenue for the Department of Health and Human Services by an estimated \$702,600 ongoing beginning in FY 2027, reflecting the federal share of Medicaid program costs.

Enactment of this legislation could cost the Department of Health and Human Services an estimated \$702,600 ongoing in Federal Funds, \$202,200 ongoing from the General Fund, and \$41,300 ongoing from the Medicaid ACA Fund in FY 2027 to cover increased Medicaid costs.
