Enactment of this legislation could increase Federal Funds revenue for the Department of Health and Human Services by an estimated \$351,900 one-time in FY 2027, reflecting the federal share of Medicaid program costs.

Enactment of this legislation could cost the Department of Health and Human Services an estimated \$351,900 one-time in Federal Funds, \$101,300 one-time from the General Fund, and \$20,700 one-time from the Medicaid ACA Fund in FY 2027 to cover increased Medicaid costs.
